## **EDITING EXAMPLE #2**

To obtain the sample, a 6 to 8 mm diameter ( $\approx 1/4$  inch) piece of skin will be taken from the underside of your arm using a sterile biopsy punch. The area will first be sterilized with alcohol wipes, and then a 25 gauge needle will be used to inject a small amount (1 ml) of local anesthetic called lido-epinephrine. If desired, a topical cream (LMX) can be used to numb the skin before the injection.
